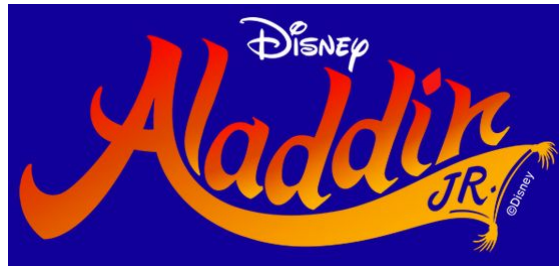


AUDITION PACKET

Audition Week: August 26th, 27th, 28th, 29th and 30th (prepare ~1 min monologue, audition song from Google Classroom, and choreography from Google Classroom)

- Sign up for audition day outside Ms. McCook's classroom
- Prepare an approximately one minute monologue to present as your audition.
 - ◆ Monologues must be memorized

- Practice and memorize the audition song, which can be found in Google Classroom.
- Practice and memorize the choreography, which can be found in Google Classroom.
- Bring a completed copy of the Audition form, found at the back of this packet, to your scheduled audition appointment.

Tentative rehearsal schedule:

- All cast: Full Cast Read Thru: September 3rd (4:15-6:00)
- Scene/Music/Choreo Rehearsals Sept 4th-Nov 1 (4:15-6:00 as scheduled)
- Full Saturday Rehearsal (all cast): November 2nd (9:00-4:00 at AMMS)
- Tech Rehearsals: Nov. 4th and Nov. 6th-8th (4:15 - 6:00)
- Saturday Tech Rehearsal at JCHS (parents/select cast/crew): November 9th (8:00-4:00)
- Dress Rehearsals: November 11th-14th at JCHS (4:45-8:00)
- Performances: November 15th and 16th at JCHS (7:00 pm)

PLEASE REVIEW ALL DRAMA CLUB POLICIES. BEING A PART OF THE MUSICAL IS A SIGNIFICANT TIME COMMITMENT. YOUR CHILD WILL NEED TO BE AVAILABLE FOR SCHEDULED REHEARSALS AND EVERY REHEARSAL DAY IN APRIL.

Attendance Policy:

Rehearsal attendance is extremely important. Any conflict that would not allow your child to be at rehearsals should be listed on the audition form. Student availability to attend rehearsals will be taken into account when roles are assigned.

- ★ Students must attend all rehearsals for which they are called, all tech week rehearsals, all dress rehearsals, and all performances.
 - Children who arrive for rehearsal when they are not scheduled will be sent to the office to call home.
- ★ 3 ABSENCES from rehearsals without an excuse or prior approval may lead to dismissal from the production.
- ★ ABSENCES FROM TECH OR DRESS REHEARSALS MAY MEAN ROLE REASSIGNMENT.
- ★ ACTORS WILL NEED TO COMMUNICATE ANY MISSED REHEARSALS WITH THE DIRECTOR
- ★ Students must be picked up at 6:00pm, or at the scheduled end of rehearsal.
 - Rehearsals may run slightly longer and as we draw closer to show time. If there are any necessary changes, I will give you as much notice as possible.

Drama Club Rules:

- Come to rehearsal with your script, music and pencil as needed for your role.
- Be ready to work during rehearsal! This is time to work on your lines, blocking and sets.
- Practice at home- have your parents read lines with you and show them your blocking.
- At all times you must stay with your group.
- RESPECT! Respect ALL VOLUNTEERS, your castmates & yourself. That includes being quiet when others are performing.

Other Important Information:

- We will provide updated information and schedules through the Drama Club website and through emails.
- Production costs typically include \$50 production fee, \$20 t-shirt fee, \$25 catering fee (for meals during Saturday rehearsals), \$50 for costumes. Specific fee sheets will be distributed after casting, and fees should be paid by September 13th.
- We welcome, encourage and need your help! All parents/guardians will be expected to provide for or volunteer 6 hours (or two committees) toward our production. A google form will be sent home after casting with signups.

Parents: Please read over each of the statements below and initial your understanding and acceptance of these items. Then, please sign and date the bottom of the form.

- My child has permission to participate in "Aladdin, Jr."
- I have reviewed the rehearsal schedule. My child will be able to rehearse during those specific dates and times, except for dates and times listed on the conflict sheet, with the understanding that tech and dress rehearsals are mandatory.
